QUESTING (GB) allowed YARA to take the lead, moved out entering the first turn, followed the aforementioned rival, moved up to challenge passing the five-eighths pole, edged clear midway through the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, extended the lead under one crack of a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip approaching the eighth-pole, held a sizeable advantage at this point, drifted out badly under continued left hand urging in the final furlong and proved much the best. ZO IMPRESSIVE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, moved closer with a half-mile to run, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, moved into second outside the quarter-pole, dropped to three wide, chased the winner through upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. IN LINGERIE angled in at the rear of the field, settled towards the back, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased two to three wide on the far turn and tired while best of the rest. DISPOSABLEPLEASURE lunged at the start and was last away, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was urged along on the far turn, tried to come between rivals outside the five-sixteenths pole, failed to have enough room, brushed with YARA then steadied and came up empty. FUNNY PROPOSITION raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer near the half-mile pole, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and faded. YARA was asked from the start, beat QUESTING to the lead, set the clear pace while on the inside, was challenged near the five-eighths pole, dropped out midway through the far turn, brushed with DISPOSABLEPLEASURE outside the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
