Footnotes

COZY APP sat forwardly placed from off the inside, was asked to pick up the pace leaving the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide for the stretch drive and took off in earnest after the leader, rallied in tandem with the runner up to go past the early pacesetter with about a sixteenth to go, shook off DIAMOND D'ORO after a couple of more jumps and edged away. DIAMOND D'ORO chased the pacesetter from off the inside, began to close the gap during the initial portion of the stretch run, raced as a team going by leaving the eighth pole, got outfinished by the winner in the last sixteenth and had to settle for the place. HOLIDAY AT BETTY'S was coaxed along tracking the front runners while sitting a loose pocket for much of the opening half, cut the corner into the lane and after having done so was taken outward, proved no match for the top twosome en route for the show. STORMY BEAUTY broke well and quickly took control, proved ratable while showing the way from the inside on a loose lead, heard hoof steps after entering the stretch and was soon asked for run, this

occurring in upper stretch, held on to the top until near the sixteenth pole, got overhauled by the first two finishers in unison and steadily weakened thereafter. CHESSRATE saved ground throughout and lacked the necessary stretch response. RENNINA failed to menace. MAYAKOBA raced between rivals and had no rally. WIRE TAP underwent a four wide pursuit and posed no threat. OUR PINK RIBBON three wide departing the backstretch, tired. FACE THE FUTURE (ARG) raced along the outside and was outrun. STORMIN ESTHER rode the rail until the five-sixteenths pole, was under some encouragement commencing to swing outward at that station, settled into the five path by the top of the lane, came up empty. LITTLE LUPE off a beat slowly, offered little.
