SPURIOUS PRECISION broke out and bumped lightly with a rival, chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leader while two to three wide on the turn, gained the advantage at the top of the stretch, responded well when asked for his best, shook clear coming to the furlong marker and drew away under steady handling. SHOW SOME MAGIC stumbled at the start then brushed with a rival but recovered quickly, chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong and was second best. WELL LAWYERED was hard ridden in fourth position, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out some in the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. EXPLORING showed good speed, set the pace on the inside, was asked for more coming to the quarter-pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and weakened. HOLDEN ON was a bit fractious in the post parade, angled in outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. HOT WEST was fractious in the post parade, unseated the rider but was nicely held onto, was last away, raced off the pace while under urging, went three to four wide on the turn, lugged inward in upper stretch and tired. SMOKE TOWN came away in good order, lacked early speed, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. THAT'S GIN was bumped lightly on both sides at the start then squeezed back, dropped well behind, saved ground on the turn and trailed.
