SAM'S BUCK raced off the hedge on the initial turn, settled on the outside, was roused while off the hedge on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up at the wire. KNOCK QUIETLY was well placed just off the pace, ranged up on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. CALL UP THE CHIEF settled on the inside, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved out approaching the furlong marker, chased KNOCK QUIETLY into the final sixteenth and finished willingly for the show. POTUS dropped to the inside on the first turn, settled near the hedge, was roused while inside on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and improved position. EL DREAMER went three wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and also improved position. SONNYANDPALLY went three wide early on the first turn then moved to the two path, settled on the outside, was roused while two to three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. JAKE'S SHAKE went four to five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. BELLAMY went two to three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and gave way. MR ALGEBRA saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, went two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. PAPA TOM contested the pace on the inside, held the lead on the far turn, was put to the whip at the top of the stretch,

lost the advantage shortly thereafter and gave way. TRAININGFORSUCCESS was eager in the early going, moved out entering the first turn, raced three to four wide on that turn, contested the pace, dropped back a bit near the half-mile pole, chased three to four wide on the far turn and capitulated. JACK'S R WILD stood in the gate, broke about three lengths behind the rest of the field, dropped well behind and trailed.
