**Footnotes**

BASALT departed the backstretch from the three path, remained forwardly placed throughout the run around the bend, crept up towards ROBERT'S BREACH approaching the quarter pole, challenged for command latched on, with the rider holding something in reserve while doing so as opposed to the more actively handled previously mentioned rival, was soon given his cue and took off opening up a comfortable advantage before reaching the eighth pole,

maintained a healthy margin to the end, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. A BOY NAMED EM was put to some urging leaving the starting gate to achieve position in midpack, sat there for the opening half, displayed a good late kick to procure the place. HOW DO I WIN pressed the issue from the outside for a half, entered the stretch having tipped three wide and got outfinished. CYBERTRON along the inside in the early going, took the two path for entrance into the lane, gained ground steadily to secure the last major check. DYLAN DANGEROUS well off the inside throughout, was put to a prolonged drive, commenced to angle four wide from the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. ROBERT'S BREACH was guided over to the rail after the start, making it there by the end of the backstretch, argued for control, was put to some urging to stay in the battle late on the turn, got hooked up the top one coming to the quarter pole, fell back soon afterwards and faltered. GREY FOOSE broke through the gate to the start, had the assistant expertly maintain his hold on the reins, helping to prevent any potential escape, was outrun for nearly a half before going on to improve position. BLUE CREEK placed seven wide by the seven-sixteenths pole, went by weak and tired ones. NONNO'S BOY was through after going a half. CREA'S LAW commenced the stretch drive six wide at head of the stretch, made no impact. VENTURA BAR saved ground throughout. MANDORLA between rivals for a good portion of the opening half, failed to reach a contending position. TRINITY WARRIOR off the inside, was no threat. WISTFUL WILDCAT departed the backstretch from the four path, folded.
