**Footnotes**

RAPSCALLION was well rated off the inside on an easy lead, moved a bit closer to the hedge on the far turn, controlled the action into the stretch, responded well when put to a drive, powered further ahead under a strong hand-ride and proved much the best under continued strong hand urging. RED VINE was reserved on the inside, waited while behind rivals on the far turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, brushed with an opponent near the three-sixteenths pole, angled further out in the vicinity of the furlong marker, bumped with INVINCIBLE ME at that point and got up for the place. SECRETIVE was carried five wide early on the initial turn, dropped to four wide shortly thereafter, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match then lost the place. TOWN EXTENSION was bumped hard at the start, dropped back between rivals early, raced off the hedge while under restraint on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, came under a drive on the outside, bumped with INVINCIBLE ME near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. ALL THAT broke in badly and bumped very hard with TOWN EXTENSION, was rated while a bit off the inside, chased near the hedge on the far turn, continued to pursue the winner into the final furlong then weakened. INVINCIBLE ME broke about two to three lengths slow, raced off the hedge while at the rear on the first turn, joined the rest of the field outside the half-mile pole, went four to five wide on the far turn while urged along, was bumped near the furlong marker then forced into another rival, drifted in at the sixteenth-pole and flattened out. MIO D'ORO was taken up while rank into the first turn, swerved four wide at that point, dropped to three wide shortly thereafter then one off the hedge late on that bend, was rated while off the inside, raced between rivals on the far turn, brushed with an opponent in upper stretch, dropped back between foes and came up empty. IRON WORKS went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn and tired. FIRST BEACH was eager along the hedge while under tight restraint on the first turn, raced off heels from about the three-quarter pole until early on the backstretch, lingered towards the rear while still under restraint, dropped back while green on the far turn and failed to respond.
