Footnotes

VINNY GOODTIMES was a bit rank while inside and behind horses through the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, was rated just off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, accelerated to the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear into the final furlong, extended the advantage while being flagged with the whip and drew away while kept to the task under an energetic hand ride. RYVIT disputed the pace on the outside, was asked near the three-eighths pole, vied into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. SHORTCOMING raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled off the pace, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted four wide late on that bend, was driven five wide into the stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong, drifted out late and just missed the place. SUNNYINSEABROOK came out some at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SOUTHERN MATCH saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to rally. RUGGED RASCAL shifted out nearing the first turn, went four wide on that bend, moved up to track the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and came up empty. TIZN'T OVER broke out at the start, went three wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, settled near the middle of the field, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came

six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. STREETS OF FIRE disputed the pace on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. JACK'S LION was last away then a bit sluggish early, lagged at the back and showed little.
