Footnotes

BOAT away well, settled into midpack along the outside, stayed within range under a good hold for nearly three-quarters, was placed in the four path at the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, entered the stretch a bit closer to the inside, took off in earnest after settling into upper stretch, gained readily during the ensuing furlong to loom boldly, drew abreast of the leader with about a sixteenth remaining, successfully wore that one down after a brief, but spirited duel, edged away under good handling. FIZZANO fought against the bit during the straightaway approach leading to the opening bend, sneaked his way over to the rail shortly before reaching the first turn and after going a few additional strides, began to rate more kindly, patiently tracked the pacesetter from slightly off the inside, angled outward getting asked to pick up the pace nearing the end of the far turn, fought his way to a narrow advantage between rivals near the eighth pole, offered good resistance before relinquishing late, continued on willingly for the place. GAMBLIN FEVER unhurried on the opening bend and down the backstretch, began to pick up pace upon reaching the second turn, advanced into contention cutting the corner into the lane, remained a prominent factor before getting out finished in the late stages. WARRIOR UP tracked the leader taking the inside route, was taken off the rail just past the quarter pole, appeared to be moving well when steadied after unsuccessfully trying to squeeze his way through between rivals in the vicinity of the eighth pole, altered course a short distance down the road, and came home willingly to grab the last major award. DUAL CITIZEN off to an alert beginning, angled to the inside, was rated on a loosely-contested pace, felt some pressure coming to the quarter pole as the closest pursuers closed the gap, was let out soon afterwards in response, held his ground for the next eighth before backing away. ROCKY WORLD lacked the necessary response. MR. HOOKER four wide into the stretch, had no kick. THE NOZ three wide around both turns, was through after completing three-quarters. TAPITDAR tracked the front runners from the inside and faded.
