WISE STOP broke running and with light encouragement from the jockey quickly established control, cut the pace, rated towards the inside and facing only mild pressure from the nearest pursuers, continued along the same scenario for the initial half, drifted out a bit when let out in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds, still with a clear advantage and despite drifting out an additional path during the last eighth held sway, driving. GRAND STRATEGY bobbled slightly, went on to assume a forward position, stalked the leader from the two path, placed just off the leader's hind quarters, was asked for a response entering the stretch, proved no match. CURE unhurried for most of the opening half, raced four wide around the bend, was already under encouragement swinging five wide into upper stretch, displayed a good kick down the outside of the strip en route for the show. STAND PROUD saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, improved position during the stretch drive. WINAHOLIC urged four wide into the lane, had no kick. AWESOME ARCENO perched in three path, was released from a firm hold midpoint on the turn, folded. DAVID THE GREAT ranged up from the outside during the run around the bend, ducked inward near the three-sixteenths pole, flattened out. LUBANGO left the rail coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was taken in hand off heels as DAVID THE GREAT angled inward in upper stretch, had no rally.
