MY MISS AURELIA away in good order, was lightly coaxed along giving chase on the pacesetter, was asked for a response turning for home, closed the gap to reach the eighth pole on nearly even terms with DELIGHTFUL MAGIC, sparred with that opponent head to head before kicking clear in the final seventy yards to prove best. DELIGHTFUL MAGIC broke alertly and was on a clear advantage well before reaching the turn, set the pace from the inside, with the top one giving pursuit in close proximity directly to the outside, got called upon as that rival increased the pressure entering the turn, saw her previous lead dwindle down to all but a head by the eighth to pole, held on with good determination before being shaking off leaving the sixteenth pole and had to settle for place honors. STOPSHOPPINGMARIA stumbled badly at the start, recovered and was mildly hand urged to take up position just off the pacesetter, took the inside route on the turn tracking that foe, fell back slightly when the front runners were let out approaching the quarter pole, was angled three wide for the stretch drive, proved no match, while well clear of the others for the show. REFINING saved ground around the turn and bested the rest. PARTY OF INTEREST settled towards the back of the pack after leaving the starting gate, was put on the receiving end of a strong grip on the left side of the reins, yet needed several strides before tucking into the two path at the seven-sixteenths pole, was under a strong drive a furlong later, failed to reach a contending position. BARGAIN BLITZ got off a bit awkwardly after lunging at the break, raced in midpack, was driven from the three path into the stretch, had no rally. BOURBONESQUE hustled away from the gate, was out sprinted for the lead nonetheless. swung four wide into the lane, and tired.
