Footnotes

PURE GOSSIP ducked inward at the start, settled into stride shortly afterwards and tracked the pacesetter while saving ground, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home with a clear passage along the rail awaiting, held a clear advantage by the three-sixteenths pole, lengthening away to a bigger margin during the ensuing sixteenth, maintained a safe winning margin, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. LENDERS WAY broke outward but was pulled off CINNAMON STICK before significant contact could be made, lost ground and momentum being steadied at the half mile pole, with SING LIKE A BIRD showing indications of being taken inside at that station, gained ground steadily under some coaxing during the run around the bend, found ample room to angle to middle of the track in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, and although never posing a serious threat to the winner, finished with good energy to procure the place. WILDCAT'S SMILE underwent a three wide pursuit, moved up to put more pressure on the leader coming to the head of the stretch, lugged inward at both the three-sixteenths pole and the furlong marker, requiring a tight grip from the rider on the right rein to counteract it each time, got out finished during the last eighth. PROUD AND CHARMING brought up the back of the pack during the initial going, raced along the inside, angled out for the stretch drive and finished well belatedly to secure the last major award, partially aided by outkicking several weakening rivals in the late stages. KARMA POLICE raced along the outside, made a mild bid entering the stretch, but soon flattened out. KIBOSH in the four path for much of the way on the turn, was taken five to six wide turning for home to avoid contact with an errant and tiring THE FUNKY EXPRESS, lacked the necessary stretch response. SING LIKE A BIRD off a bit awkwardly, raced in midpack and made no serious bids. PROJECT RUNAWAY broke running and sped by the field to take charge early, angled over towards the inside, proved obstinate refusing several attempts by the rider to tuck along the rail, showed the way from the two path, succumbed once the pressure increased in upper stretch, tired steadily thereafter. THE FUNKY EXPRESS moved up to midpack under her own power, stayed within range three wide on the turn, drifted outward an additional path entering the stretch, began to back away in short order. BARREL OF JOY raced along the outside and was outrun. CINNAMON STICK off the inside, was coaxed along giving chase, folded.
