**Footnotes**

JACKSON BEND brushed with rivals after the start, was well placed just off the pace, came under some urging while near the inside on the turn, espied an inside opening at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail while under strong hand urging, gained the lead passing the furlong marker, was put to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter and edged clear under a continued right-handed whip then hand urging near the wire. HAMAZING DESTINY stalked the pace on the outside, ranged up to make a bid while three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled with JACKSON BEND and ESCROW KID into the final furlong then was outfinished while able to get the place. ESCROW KID brushed with JACKSON BEND after the start, moved up on the inside to take the lead, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked for more outside the quarter-pole, came off the inside at the top of the stretch, battled between rivals into the final furlong then weakened while able to get the show. HERE COMES BEN settled near the back of the field, moved in with a half-mile to run, was urged along while inside on the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, moved out under left hand urging in upper stretch, continued further out in the final furlong and lacked the needed response. AIKENITE settled off the pace, was ridden along while two then three wide on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. CAIXA ELETRONICA settled on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE was reserved on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. D' FUNNYBONE lost his footing a bit at the start, showed good speed then pressed the pace, vied between rivals on the turn, dropped out in upper stretch and faded.
