Footnotes

DRIVEN BY SOLAR chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, gained a short lead outside the furlong marker, disposed of LITTLE NICK inside that marker and powered clear under energetic handling. LITTLE NICK was away alertly, quickly showed in front, set the pace, vied a tad off the inside on the turn, lost the lead outside the furlong marker, fought on with the winner then proved no match while able to get the place. SILVER TIMBER brushed with a rival nearing the half-mile pole, dropped towards the inside, waited behind rivals passing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the show. NEW BELIEVER angled in at the rear of the field, raced two to three wide on the turn, shifted five wide outside the quarter-pole and improved position. DANCINGALL THEWAY chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and lacked the needed kick. DUKE OF NAPLES was hustled from the start, jostled with ITS GOODTOBEKING near the half-mile pole then dropped back while in tight, waited while two to three wide on the turn, found room outside the three-sixteenths pole and also lacked the needed kick. GALAXY KAT settled towards the rear, angled in late on the backstretch, dropped to the inside near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. FORALLTHEGLORY bumped with a rival at the start, was urged some while on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and weakened. STAR DISTINCTION broke awkwardly then bumped with FORALLTHEGLORY, raced off heels outside the half-mile pole, went four to five wide on the turn and came up empty. EZZY was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on

the turn and failed to threaten. ITS GOODTOBEKING was last away, moved up while amongst horses, jostled with DUKE OF NAPLES near the half-mile pole, raced between rivals on the turn and dropped out.
