Footnotes

HARDROCKER stalked the leader on the outside, chased on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and held under strong urging. CURRENT DESIGN settled while off the inside, was roused while three to four wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong, gained ground on the outside, lugged in some late and earned the place. RANGEY set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and was outfinished while just able to get the show. BR. ALEXANDER went three wide early on the first turn then dropped into the two path, settled just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and finished willingly to just miss the show. MASTER OF MARKETS saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while inside on the far turn, moved out some near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. LE GRAND ARTISTE was well placed just behind the leader while on the inside, chased on the far turn, squeezed through along the hedge in upper stretch, steadied when unable to accelerate through on the inside and weakened. DREAMALOT was antsy in the gate, broke near the back of the field, saved

ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn and failed to threaten. MONEYINYOUR POCKET brushed the outside stall door at the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. VENGEFUL PRIDE raced two then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, angled in with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn and also failed to rally. ASTONISH lingered near the back while off the rail, came under urging on the far turn and was no factor. URAGANO dropped back immediately while taking choppy strides, fell extremely far behind and was distanced despite being ridden to the end.
