Footnotes

STOP SIGN came away in good order, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, disposed of DAPPER DRAPER entering the final furlong and held under steady urging. FOGGY ROAD bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, lacked speed while urged along, went two to three wide on the turn, raced behind a rival at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to the inside in upper stretch, gained into the final furlong, moved out while closing in the final sixteenth and finished well but was too late while clear for the place. OPTIONALITY was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, angled out sharply in upper stretch, reached the outside of the field by the eighth-pole and just got up for the show. LINCOLN FLYER was ridden along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, lugged inward in upper stretch and just missed the show. GIANT'S TIME bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the inside, dropped to the rail midway through the turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DAPPER DRAPER pressed the pace on the outside, came three wide into the stretch, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and tired. LIKE A BOSS was hustled from the start, settled on the outside, went three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SOUTHERN SAFARI moved out while rated off the early pace, chased three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated. MR. WILLIAM broke through the gate prior to the start, was well placed just off the pace, needed a little left-rein pressure to keep him in leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn and had nothing left.
