Footnotes

LE MI GEAUX broke outward and bumped with a rival, was hard ridden towards the rear, raced three to four wide on the turn, closed well to get the lead late then inched clear under strong urging. STOPSPENDINGMARIA jostled with a rival while dueling on the backstretch, vied off the rail on the turn, inched clear into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to hold the place. SHOW ME THE BLING dueled on the outside, bumped with LET'S GET FISCAL entering the turn, raced three wide on the turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong, ducked in near the sixteenth-pole and weakened while clear for the show. LET'S GET FISCAL jostled with rivals while dueling between horses on the backstretch, bumped with SHOW ME THE BLING entering the turn, vied three wide on the turn, battled into upper stretch then faltered. DOS LUNAS broke a bit in the air and was off a step slow, raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn and failed to respond. SPA SUNRISE bumped with a rival at the start, jostled with rivals while between horses on the backstretch, dropped back near the half-mile pole, moved to the rail on the turn and stopped.
