Footnotes

DEANAALLEN'SKITTEN dropped in behind rivals and was reserved while off the rail, drafted behind horses while two then three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied under a right-handed whip, accelerated to the lead inside the furlong marker, was switched to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. SHATOOSH set the pace on the inside through moderate fractions, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to hold the place. GREAT GRACIE DANE settled on the inside, moved a bit closer on the far turn, drafted behind rivals outside the quarter-pole, steadied briefly off heels at the top of the stretch, altered course to the inside, was put to a left-handed whip and finished willingly along the rail to garner the show. ARCH SUPPORT settled on the inside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, bided her time while saving ground on the far turn, came off the rail and was asked at the top of the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. FONT was taken under a strong hold while eager and just off heels in the early going, lagged near the back while under a strong hold, came under light encouragement on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly between rivals but missed the minor awards. WAR CLAN broke out a bit at the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under some urging while four then five wide on the far turn, was carried seven wide into the stretch, came under a drive shortly thereafter and also lacked the needed kick. UP IN LIGHTS was reserved under a strong hold while saving ground, came off the inside near the five-sixteenths pole, was guided out approaching the furlong marker and lacked the needed response while gaining ground. MY PERFECT LIGHT was rank while washy in the early going, bumped repeatedly with ROCKETTES ESCAPADE near the seven-eighths pole, went three wide on the first turn, pressed the leader on the outside, was asked at the top of the stretch, came up empty when put to a drive and tired. ROCKETTES ESCAPADE bumped repeatedly with a rank MY PERFECT LIGHT near the seven-eighths pole then checked nearing the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased three then four wide on the far turn, went wrong coming to the top of the stretch and was pulled up then vanned off. (Rail at 9 Feet)
