IT'S TRICKY away in good order, settled into a forward position, contently stalked the pacesetter three wide, was let out a notch soon after entering the far turn, reached nearly even terms briefly in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole only to fall back slightly again, was under a full drive entering the stretch, contrasting sharply with the rider still sitting chilly on the leader, failed to dent into the pacesetter's margin as the pair made their way through the furlong grounds, drawing off from the rest of the field, began to close in leaving the furlong marker, drew abreast at the sixteenth pole, continued onward with good courage and under strong handling to wrest away the lead during the final seventy yards to prove best. PLUM PRETTY broke on top despite appearing to bobble slightly at the start, needed only a few strides out of the gate to take control, sat entrenched in the two path, setting the splits, under the watchful of the top one all the while, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, got called upon after entering the stretch, lost little if any of her advantage during the ensuing furlong, felt the winner's presence soon afterwards, relinquished with about seventy yards to go and had to settle for being second best. ROYAL DELTA placed under a firm hold, began to rate kindly upon reaching the first turn, brought up the back of the pack while undergoing a three wide journey, proved no match for the top twosome during the stretch run. BUSTER'S READY forwardly placed along the inside for a half, faded. JOYFUL VICTORY swung into the backstretch from the four path, raced well off the inside throughout, was through after completing six furlongs.
