Footnotes

WISHINGONASTAR off in good order, maintained a forward position down the backstretch, gave chase well off the inside around the turn, was asked to pick up the pace nearing the end of the bend, spun from the four path into the stretch and took off in earnest after settling into upper stretch, gained ground steadily during the run through the furlong grounds, forged on ahead, went by QUIET POWER a couple of strides after that one had grabbed command and edged away, driving. QUIET POWER underwent a four wide pursuit, moved up to challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, had just worked his way to the front when overhauled by the top one, continued on willingly to secure second. JUNGLE RAIN was knocked sideways after making hard contact with GOOD TO BE ME at the start, shook it off and established control well before reaching the end of the backstretch, took up residence in the two path while setting the splits, felt intensified pressure late on the turn, was let out in response to it, clung to a narrow edge after making his way through the furlong grounds, showed good determination before yielding about a sixteenth later and had to settle for the show. BLACK DIABLO off the inside, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, altered course outward to be widest off all to obtain optimal racing clearance in upper stretch, kicked in with good late foot after completing the maneuver en route for the last major slice of the pot. RIZZI'S COMET unhurried during the initial stages, picked up interest while advancing into contention on the turn, cut the corner into the lane under encouragement, made some additional progress in the next furlong but could not sustain the momentum departing the eighth pole. FREUDS ANA STREAK tucked into the pocket down the backstretch, tracked the front runner, failed to fire when called upon in upper stretch. SWINGING AT SIRO'S was taken off the rail at the half mile pole, got placed five wide at the head of the stretch, lacked the necessary response. GOOD TO BE ME was taken in hand after being bumped soundly between rivals at the start, made a mild middle move on the turn, flattened out soon afterwards. HOUSTON HARBOR bobbed at the break, sat within range towards the inside for the opening half, had no stretch offering to render. CAMIE'S HOT chased three wide and was through after completing a half. GYPSY WIND swung into the six path at the top of the lane, was never a threat. MAKE MY MOVE raced three wide, was urged on the turn, failed to menace. KARAKORUM BUDMAN bumped hard at the start, offered little. AS PER RULING ST-69-2011, DATED SEPTEMBER 17,2011, QUIET POWER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND UNPLACED DUE TO POSITIVE TEST.
