Footnotes

CAPITAL MARKET tucked over to the hedge near the end of the homestretch, was rated cutting the pace until the quarter pole, got let out once the closest pursuers were likewise asked for run, added to his advantage during the ensuing furlong, heard hoof steps coming from the direction of the inside in deep stretch, just reached the wire in time to preserve the decision. TAHOE LAKE (BRZ) judiciously rode the hedge around the opening bend, was swung outward entering the backstretch, eventually settling into the three path at midpoint, was guided back to the inside for the run around the far turn, crept up into contention, availing of opportunities being provided as rival after rival abandoned the hedge, turned for home still hugging the inside, paused for a stride or two behind CODE OF CONDUCT in upper stretch, gained a fully clear inside passage when the previously mentioned foe angled outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, kicked in with good energy once fully roused, closed in strongly on the top one but came up one jump short. CLEAR ATTEMPT sat within range from off the inside, was placed in the three path midway on the second turn, in preparation for the stretch drive, closed the gap from the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, continued on with good courage thereafter to secure the show. CODE OF CONDUCT saved ground on the far turn, angled outward during the initial portion of his stretch drive, rallied well en route for the final major check. POLICE CHATTER rode the pocket until the quarter pole, got out finished. LISTON strung out in the three path on the first turn, found room to maneuver a bit closet to the inside for the subsequent one, went on to improve position down the lane. RUBBER DUCK (GER) saved ground, lost some ground and momentum angling three wide into the lane, lacked the necessary response. QUICK RECOVERY three wide around both turns, was through after completing three-quarters. QUIET ASSAULT accompanied the winner from the outside until the top of the lane. ARNELL raced along the outside and tired. PRETTY BOY FREUD displayed brief foot, was put to a protective hold and eased entering the stretch.
