JIMMY SIMMS was well rated on the inside with an easy lead, controlled the tempo through the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, switched to a left-handed whip late and held under strong handling. GATHERING CLOUD was rated just behind the leader while on the inside, waited patiently on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker then was put to a right-handed whip, loomed just behind the winner into the final sixteenth and finished willingly but missed. COLONIALISM raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole, went back to the right-hand late and finished willingly for the show but lacked the needed winning kick. KING'S COMMAND was in tight off heels then bobbled near the seven-eighths pole, raced towards the rear while under restraint, came under light urging while three wide on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, was put to the whip outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. JOHANNESBURG SMILE was rated just behind the leader while on the outside, chased that rival on the far turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch and weakened. RODDICKTON settled between rivals, dropped back early on the far turn and failed to rally. SEASIDE RETREAT was in tight off heels entering the first turn then reserved on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and also failed to rally. WESTSHORE went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field and was no factor. (Rail at 9 Feet)
