Footnotes

VEILED PROPHET was reserved while eager in the early going, raced on the inside while under a tight hold, was given some free rein near the half-mile pole, came off the inside leaving the backstretch, patiently turned into the stretch while behind rivals, was asked shortly thereafter, moved to the outside, rallied under strong hand urging, gained ground on the outside while being flashed the whip, joined the battling leaders passing the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. CARSON HALL stalked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled with ATTRACTIVE RIDE while under drive, fought with that rival into the final sixteenth, was joined by the winner on the outside and missed while able to get the place. ATTRACTIVE RIDE easily took the lead, was well rated while on the inside, lobbed along in front, was joined by CARSON HALL on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled with CARSON HALL, drifted out when put to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed whip, fought with the top two and missed while able to get the show. FLAMIN' HOT was eager in the early going, went two to three wide while under restraint on the first turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. RED LEADER was eager off heels early then a bit rank on the first turn, continued under restraint, came under some urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. LISTON was reserved while eager early, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the back, raced inside on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and gained some ground but failed to menace. GLOWING PRAISE (GB) was taken back under a very strong hold early, raced just behind the leader while on the inside, became more kindly rated on the backstretch, drafted behind horses while inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, pursued the leaders under a drive and also lacked the needed kick. SAFETY VALVE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty.
