Footnotes

DA MI BASIA MILLE made light contact with CITIZEN EMMA leaving the starting gate, bobbed after appearing to take a bad step over some soft going crossing the wire the first time, settled along the inside soon afterwards, remained well reserved while taking the inside route making her way down the backstretch, was eased into the two path midway on the far turn, began to pick up interest heading for the top of the lane and got turned loose, made up ground on the front runners readily during the ensuing furlong, continued onward with good energy, grabbed the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker and edged away under good handling. CITIZEN EMMA brushed with the top one at the start, took up position in midpack from off the inside and remained unhurried for over three-quarters, entered the stretch three wide and already under urging, came home with good energy to procure the place. EMOTIONAL KITTEN away from the starting gate in good order, led a strung out field in the initial stages, saving ground and with the pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins, continued along a loosely-contested lead for over six furlongs, felt some pressure for the first time heading for the quarter pole and got called upon for a response, held her ground stubbornly until the sixteenth pole, yielded at that station and had to eventually settle for show honors. ZADINA loped along at the backstretch, was briefly off the rail down the backstretch only to re tuck along the inside by the seven-sixteenths pole,. swung back outward during the later stages of the run around the second turn, was under a drive swinging three wide into the lane, found her best stride with about a sixteenth to go en route to earning the last major check. BROKEN SPELL saved ground throughout, made steady progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, ran out of running room in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole with no potential escape route to the outside available, kept pace as best as possible under light urging while blocked in traffic. AVENTURINE off the inside, lacked the needed response. MINNIE BEAR displayed some green ness proceeding down the homestretch, fighting with vigor on the bit in resistance to the hold being applied by the rider and climbing for a couple of strides as well, settled down and

went more professionally soon after reaching the opening bend, stalked afar initially, steadily advanced into contention under light hand urging leaving the half mile pole, kept up the pursuit under stronger handling until the eighth pole, fell back steadily when unable to sustain the bid. RADIANT CUT three wide and asked at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to respond. OMNITAP failed to menace. BILLBOARD BABE underwent a tepid chase, ducked over to the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and faltered.
