SOUL HOUSE got off a beat slowly, with the rider grabbing hold to avoid contact with an errant DARK ROAST leaving the starting gate, raced along the outside with only one rival beat during the run around the bend, spun from the three path into the lane already under encouragement, got straightened away and got set down to a full hard drive, made up a good amount of real estate during the ensuing furlong, continued to close in, drawing even with the second place finisher a sixteenth down the rood, took over soon afterwards and kicked clear, kept busy to the end. WEEKEND HIDEAWAY broke slightly to the outside, moved up willingly proceeding towards the end of the backstretch and hooked up in a duel with POLAN from along the outside, sparred on nearly even terms, was asked for a response entering the stretch and gave it, shook off his nemesis to arrive at the eighth pole with none latched on, felt the top one's presence in short order, yielded to that rival with about a sixteenth remaining, continued on with good energy though for the place. DARK ROAST ducked in awkwardly at the start, showed some early zip to grab a forward post, tucked along the inside coming to the half mile pole, tracked the embattled pair up ahead, riding the rail until the five-sixteenths pole, commenced to angle three wide for the stretch drive, ducked outward several paths from upper to mid lane after only two interspersed left handed shots, proved no match for the two pair. BRASSY EGO disputed the pace as the innermost of three in the initial stages, was taken hold and eased back coming to the end of the backstretch, sat within range making his way around the turn, was swung outward and entered the stretch four wide and under urging, got carried out several lanes by DARK ROAST in the furlong grounds, held on well enough for the final major award. POLAN argued for command from the inside on the turn, kept up the fight until the furlong grounds then gave way. ECONOMY OF WORDS urged from the get-go, saved ground until the quarter pole, made no headway on the front runners. MAD WITH FEVER bobbled at the break and trailed.
