**Footnotes**

GRANDPA LEN went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, remained patient as a rival advanced to his outside leaving the backstretch, went three wide early on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved to four wide, chased the leaders into the stretch, dropped inside those rivals once straightened for the drive, rallied under the whip, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole and inched clear under strong urging. TIZ YANKEE set the pace on the inside, was challenged leaving the backstretch, vied under urging on the far turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, battled with FLASHY SUNRISE into the final furlong, lost the lead to the winner near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the place. FLASHY SUNRISE went two then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside but behind rivals, was taken out from cover near the half-mile pole, advanced quickly on the outside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied three to four wide on the turn, was carried five wide outside the quarter-pole, battled with TIZ YANKEE into the final furlong, vied into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. DRILL SERGEANT moved in before the first turn, saved ground on that turn, settled towards the rear, was ridden along on the far turn and finished willingly late. ESCAPE ARTIST settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came a bit off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and also finished willingly late. INVOCATION rated under a tight hold while off the rail on the first turn, was well placed down the backstretch, chased on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. BEACH BOY ALEX went three then two wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while two to three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ALAJMAL raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired.
