LUNAR VICTORY away well from the starting gate, assumed the role of stalker from the get-go, sat patiently parked along the outer border of the two path until the half mile pole, ranged up and drew alongside JOHANNESBURG SMILE before going an additional sixteenth, raced head to head with the aforementioned foe, began to shake free in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, under his own power and contrasting with the riding tactics being applied by the pilot of his nemesis, held a clear advantage leading the field into the lane, was called upon and drew off, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, was kept busy until the last seventy yards, reaching the wire in plenty of time to prove best. SAILMATE off the inside, chased the front runners from off the inside, was asked for run by the three-eighths pole, kicked in well enough in the late stages to wear down the loser of the pace battle for place honors. JOHANNESBURG SMILE dashed over to the rail soon after the start with the eventual winner hot on his heels directly to the outside, drew off with that rival, had the winner draw abreast shortly after leaving the backstretch to initiate a gap duel, sparred as a team until approaching the five-sixteenths marker, fell back steadily despite being asked for some run the rest of the way to the quarter pole, then got out finished in deep stretch for second. PURE ATTITUDE saved ground to no avail. GOOD KARMA trailed throughout.
