MYMICH was hustled along early, raced inside and lacked a rally. CRIMSON AND ROSES was outrun early and had no rally. JAZZ LADY dropped back early, raced inside and had no response when roused. MIKE'S WILDCAT dueled for the lead from the outside and tired in the stretch. OH FUDGE raced wide and tired.
