**Footnotes**

DESERT WARRIOR broke a bit slowly, trailed while saving ground to the top of the stretch, angled to the outside in upper stretch then unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to get up in the final strides. PARIS ADVENTURE was reserved early between horses, angled five wide for clear sailing at the top of the stretch, came in slightly in upper stretch, accelerated to the front opening a clear advantage in midstretch, continued on the lead into deep stretch then drifted out under left hand urging causing FLIP AND STU to take up sharply in the closing strides. INTELLIGENT MALE steadied after breaking in sharply and bumping with FLIP AND STU at the start, forced the early pace from outside, raced in close contention between horses into upper stretch then finished willingly to gain a share. PARIS SUNRISE pressed the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. HOGAN'S SPIRIT checked after stumbling at the start, rushed up to gain the early advantage, extended his lead on the turn, continued on the front into upper stretch, remained a factor after relinquishing the lead in midstretch then took up sharply while lacking room in the late stages. FLIP AND STU checked while being bumped off stride at the start, failed to menace while seven wide on the turn. HEAVENLY KEVIN raced within striking distance while four wide for a half and tired. Following a steward's inquiry into the stretch run PARIS ADVENTURE was disqualified from second and placed fifth for interference in deep stretch.
