CHAPEL ROYAL, well placed in the early stages, tucked in behind the leaders while saving ground for a half, swung out to launch his bid at the op of the stretch, accelerated to the front in upper stretch, opening a clear advantage despite jumping puddles nearing the furlong marker, extended his lead while jumping again in deep stretch then drew off while being ridden out. BLUSHING INDIAN was unhurried along the backstretch, rallied along the inside leaving the turn, drifted out leaving the eighth pole then finished with good energy in the middle of the track to clearly best the others. FLUSHING MEADOWS moved up from outside to contest the early pace, battled heads apart in the two path through the turn, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch then weakened from his early efforts. BOSTON BRAHMIN set or forced the pace along the rail into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. ADAGE drifted to the outside while appearing to have trouble handling the track along the backstretch and was never close thereafter. PRETTY WILD AGAIN, reserved early, raced in traffic while between horses on the far turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. HECKLE stumbled at the start, rushed up from outside to contest the early pace then gave way on the turn.
