Footnotes

MINESWEPT assumed the role of stalker soon after leaving the gate, sat poised three wide just off the leader's hind quarters under a good hold, advanced when ready to draw abreast of the pacesetter by midway on the turn, still well in hand, spurted away when put to a vigorous hand ride after entering the lane, and increased the winning margin while kept busy to the end. JOHN WYATT reserved off the inside, was asked for run nearing the five-sixteenths pole, finished well enough to be along in time for the place. ABILIO showed the way from the two path, with the top one in close proximity just to the outside, felt pressure for the initial time after going a half, raced on even terms until the quarter pole, yielded readily while drifting out during the ensuing furlong, then was outkicked for the place in the late stages as well. MR. VANTASTIC four wide, was put to a prolonged drive but lacked a good closing kick. WINNING TOKEN saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and was never a menace. LEATHERHEAD hit the gate and trailed.
