Footnotes

NEVER RIGHT JOEY came in at the start and brushed with a rival, dueled on the inside while right against the rail, vied inside on the turn, brushed with D' SAUVAGE in upper stretch, disposed of that rival passing the furlong marker then powered clear under good handling. D' SAUVAGE broke a bit slow, rushed up on the backstretch, chased four then three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, brushed with the winner in upper stretch and tired while clear for the place. TALL TALE TELLER was forced in early then taken up when in tight, dropped to the rear of the field, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and got up for the show. COOKS FOREST brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along on the inside, dropped back near the half-mile pole, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. ROBBIE'S TURN chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leader while off the rail on the turn, dropped out entering the stretch and gave way. PRIVATE RULES was hustled from the start, lugged in early, dueled on the outside, dropped back early on the turn and faded. CRAFTY CONCORDE broke a bit slow then brushed with a rival, moved up to race just off heels, bumped with BRISTOL HARBOUR leaving the backstretch, was blocked behind horses while inside midway through the turn then came up empty. BRISTOL HARBOUR was urged along while off the pace, bumped with CRAFTY CONCORDE leaving the backstretch and retreated while off the rail.
