SPA CITY FEVER was well rated on the inside, shook clear inside the furlong marker and held well under right hand urging. COME UNDONE settled on the inside, moved off the inside near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SAGINAW was in tight off heels on the first turn then rated just off the pace, dropped back while in tight again near the half-mile pole, raced two then three wide on the far turn, moved out a bit nearing the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. MIDNIGHT BILLY came out at the start, lingered well back in the field while off the hedge and finished willingly but missed the show. PRINCE DUBAI saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved out midway down the backstretch, raced three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. HANGINGBYATHREAD bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, raced four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. DUKE OF NAPLES bumped with a rival at the start, raced two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside while under a hold, held a good striking position into the final furlong but came up empty and gave way. ALLTIFFEDOFF raced near the hedge on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, moved out a bit near the furlong marker and had nothing left. STORMY SUCCESS raced off the hedge on the first turn, lagged

at the rear, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. GOOD KARMA settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to respond. TOO AMENABLE raced off the hedge on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and dropped out.
