BRETTON WOODS left well but was taken in hand as she settled towards the back of the pack, moved up into midpack still hugging the rail as a couple of foes vacated the inside route, found room to slip into the three path in time for the stretch drive, responded well when given her cue, loomed boldly arriving at the eighth pole, continued on with good courage, grabbing the lead in deep stretch to prove best. SHAKEIRA sat reserved from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, was placed three wide at the head of the stretch, gained ground readily on the front runners during the ensuing furlong, came inward, depriving VICTORYAT LAST of her path and forcing that rival to be taken in hand, split rivals with good energy in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and finished gamely to garner the place. LEMON TIGER left the rail coming to the half mile pole, was fanned five wide into upper stretch and displayed good belated rally to secure the show. NURSE DOLCE contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, paused twice, both just prior to and then just past the three-sixteenths pole, rather than attempt to venture through tight quarters, had sufficient racing room for the final furlong and flattened out. SKIPS PROSPECT raced along the outside, was urged on the turn but lacked the needed response. GLORY IN MOTION three wide around both turns, remained a forward factor until upper stretch before backing away. SARAH'S PLEASURE came away well and quickly established control under her own power, set the pace well rated along the inside, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, was let out as pressure from the closest pursuers increased, held her ground for an additional eighth then gave way. CATCHAPENNY K. was never involved. VICTORYAT LAST attended the pacesetter from the outside, under a firm hold for the opening six furlongs, was cut off by the runner up approaching the eighth pole, and failed to regain interest thereafter.
