LAVENDER LANE raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while inside on the far turn, made a bid along the rail in upper stretch, dueled gamely in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. MALIBU SPICE raced three wide on the first turn, stalked

the leader on the outside, inched a bit closer on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, dueled between rivals in the final furlong and just missed in a game effort. SHE DRIVES ME WILD was rated inside on the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, dueled gamely on the outside in the final furlong and just missed in a three-way photo. SIWANOY LILA dropped to the inside midway through the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was challenged in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth then weakened. SHE'S FOR REAL settled nicely while off the rail, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed response. FROTHY MARKET jostled with FALL INTO FAITH in the early going, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, moved out some in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. LEMME settled on the inside, bided her time while continuing to save ground on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and came up empty. PERSISTENCE raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved near the back, came under urging while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. WINERY was caught four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch then gave way. FALL INTO FAITH jostled with FROTHY MARKET in the early going, was reserved at the back while on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to threaten. TIBER raced three wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. SNIPP raced two then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went three then four wide on the far turn, drifted five wide nearing the quarter-pole and faltered.
