Footnotes

DEHERE OF THE CAT moved up after the start, pressed the leader on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch, drew even with HALF LIT just inside the furlong marker, battled with that rival into the final sixteenth and proved best under good handling. HALF LIT was reluctant to load, came away alertly, showed good speed and set the pace, vied inside while under urging on the turn, was asked for more at the top of the stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while able to get the place. TUG OF WAR chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the top two into the final sixteenth, switched to a left-handed whip late and lacked the needed kick while well clear for the show. READTHEBYLINE raced just off the pace while under some restraint and off the rail, came under urging in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the stretch and weakened. CYBERTRON lugged out badly while green on the backstretch, was wrestled closer to the inside by the half-mile pole, continued to lug out while four wide on the turn, straightened out under a right-handed whip in the stretch and failed to rally. SWAG DADDY showed early speed on the inside, was eased back behind the leader outside the half-mile pole, chased inside on the turn and tired. UTOPIAN DREAM angled in while beaten for speed, saved ground early on the turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to the whip in upper stretch and failed to threaten.
