HAPPY BULL set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked for more in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and gamely held off the fast closing runner-up. QUE POSSE broke out at the start, showed no speed while ridden along, dropped well behind the field, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter, switched to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the eighth-pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed fast but was too late. BOJAN pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, battled with the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to save the show. SUN DANCE MOON was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, was put to the whip near the furlong marker and finished willingly but just missed the minor awards. FORDANGSHORE showed good speed, pressed the pace between rivals, drew even while still between rivals on the turn, dropped back under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and tired. ATONED settled off the pace, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and failed to threaten.
