WAR COLONY got away awkwardly after attempting to duck inward at the start, narrowing missing making contact with the gate, moved up willingly to assume a forward position, vied from the three path with multiple foes departing the backstretch, went one on one with the runner up from midpoint on the turn, shook free shortly before reaching the quarter pole, was set down to a drive and held sway. LINDELL A. C. disputed the pace from the inside with more than one other opponent down the backstretch and for most of the way on the turn, lost contact with the eventual winner nearing the head of the stretch, altered course at the three-sixteenths pole before taking another crack at the top one, had to settle for the place. MR. POPPS lagged towards the rear of the pack for nearly a half, commenced to rally in earnest six wide at the top of the lane, the second widest of all, and flashed good late energy to grab the show. LEMON GHOST coaxed along chasing the ongoing pace dispute, lacked the necessary stretch response. TIZ A THEME swung five wide into the stretch and improved position. VAMEL saved ground around the turn, angled outward in upper stretch, went by weak and tired ones with a mild run before flattening out. GRANGERARDO four wide departing the backstretch, pressed the pace until the eighth pole and tired. LLOYDOBLER hustled away from the starting gate, failed to menace. AFLEET'S ACCLAIM raced along the outside, was under a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, tired. SCOTCHIRISH saved ground throughout. EXCISE THE DEMONS was no factor. CAPTAIN BUZZBEE steadied at the start, saved ground until the stretch, was outrun. SURF ROAD off the inside, was through after completing a half. OVERRATED TOAD briefly disputed the pace between rivals, wilted.
