STAKES Sanford S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any point prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers if there are six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. A bonus of \$200,000 jointly sponsored by Fasig-Tipton and NYRA will go to the owner of the first two-year old purchased at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings sale to win a graded stake at Saratoga (The Schuylerville, The Sanford, The Adirondack, The Three Chimneys Saratoga Special, The With Anticipation, The Spinaway or The Three Chimneys Hopeful.) 121lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2lbs.; Maidens, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 9, 2011 with 32 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

Footnotes

OVERDRIVEN broke alertly, was abreast of BLACK RHINO for a few strides before being taken in hand and allowed to drop back slightly, sat perched just off the aforementioned rival's hind quarters for the remainder of the way down the backstretch, unleashed a bold burst of speed early on the bend to reach even terms with the pacesetter by midpoint, raced head to head with that opponent, well poised but with the rider unwilling to release his firm grip on the reins prematurely, kicked clear when given his cue nearing the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage and lengthened away, under brisk handling, while being intermittently flashed the whip right handed in the final furlong. POWER WORLD bobbled slightly at the start, was coaxed along to keep pace down the backstretch, sat within range from the outside during the run around the turn, spun three wide under encouragement into the stretch and rallied to get up for the place. JACK'S IN THE DECK unhurried for nearly a half, came four wide for the stretch drive, proved no match for the top twosome en route for show honors. BLACK RHINO ducked inward, making solid contact with TARPY'S GOAL a short distance from the starting gate, moved up willingly under a snug hold to assume the early lead, felt pressure from the winner soon after entering the turn, sparred on even terms for a furlong beginning from the three-eighths pole, being asked for some run to keep pace late on the turn, was shaken off once the top one was let out in upper stretch, tired steadily thereafter. MOONRUSH off a beat slowly, ducked to the rail in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was through after completing a half. TARPY'S GOAL was bumped after the break, raced along the outside, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole, but could no headway on the front runners.
