Footnotes

WHERE'S DANNY (IRE) was bumped at the start, settled towards the rear while under some urging, went three wide early on the turn then shifted to the four path, continued four wide into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed strongly into the final sixteenth, surged past the dueling leaders late and moved clear under good handling. COWBOY PRINCE set the pace under pressure, came off the rail into the turn then dropped back to the inside,

dueled with SHOW ME SOME LOVIN, continued to duel with that rival in the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while able to get the place. SHOW SOME LOVIN stumbled at the start then bumped hard with the winner but recovered quickly, pressed the pace on the outside, dueled three then two wide on the turn, battled with COWBOY PRINCE into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to hold the show. INDIAN STYLE was ridden along while well back in the field, went two to three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy but missed the show. LASSO moved in early then was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide from behind a rival outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DOURO broke a bit slow, lacked speed at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn, angled seven wide into upper stretch, drifted out a bit after straightening for the drive, drifted out again inside the furlong marker and improved position. ALVEAR was ridden along on the outside, went four then three wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail before the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. RIDE A SONG was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn and failed to rally. THEBOYFROMBOHOLA brushed with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, lugged out a bit while four then five wide on the turn and was no factor. CAROLINA CHANT showed no speed while ridden along, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and was outrun. HARRIER HILL was hustled from the start then ridden along on the outside of SAYAPRAYERFORME, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. SAYAPRAYERFORME was ridden along on the inside of HARRIER HILL, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left.
