**Footnotes**

NEVADA saved ground during the opening stages, tipped into the three path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung one path wider into the stretch having been put to strong handling, mustered up a strong kick and forged to the front by the end of the furlong grounds, dug in well to spoil the resurgent runner up's comeback attempt. TOWN HALL quickly established control, was initially along the inside route showing the way, facing some resistance from rivals parked to his outside for much of the way to the half mile pole, drifted out gradually into the three path for the start of the run around the far bend, shook free of the others during its later stages to build up an almost four length advantage coming to the quarter pole, bore out badly, letting the closest pursers back into the contest as a result, staged a brave comeback to outfinish all but one of the them to earn place honors. BELIEF SYSTEM stalked the runner up from off the inside, followed that foe outward, raced three to four wide on the second bend, under a prolonged drive that had commenced a few strides past the half mile pole, was between rivals vying for command in upper stretch, got outfinished and had to settle for the show. SUMMER SANDS three wide into the backstretch, was closer to the rail on the far turn, spun into the lane under a drive vying with another pair for command, flattened out. LIBERTY WING underwent a four wide journey to the head of the stretch, tired in the final furlong. BEACHVIEW TWO guided over to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, had no rally. ROCKFIELD strung out in the four path on the opening bend, was along the rail by the subsequent one, was never in contention. BEDOUIN NOW drifted four wide into the stretch while tiring.
