**Footnotes**

SAMIAM was a bit eager into the first turn, raced on the outside while under some restraint, came under some urging while three wide on the far turn, was asked for more outside the quarter-pole, drifted in a path while taking the lead in upper stretch, led into the final furlong and held determinedly under a strong right-handed whip. PLEASANT CAT raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, saved ground early on the far turn then came off the inside, shifted four wide approaching the quarter-pole, bumped lightly with INDUSTRIAL POLICY in upper stretch, advanced on the outside, chased into the final furlong, loomed boldly on the outside but couldn't get by the winner while able to get the place. INDUSTRIAL POLICY went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came under urging near the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the far turn, bumped lightly with the runner-up in upper stretch, dropped inward in the vicinity of the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. CELTIC ARCH saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly to just miss the place. SHORTBREAD SCOTTY was a bit eager into the first turn, saved ground on that bend, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. GO BABY GO GO was reserved on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn, shifted off the rail at the quarter-pole, moved out behind horses while under urging in upper stretch, reached the outside of the field in the final furlong and failed to rally. CALLANA went to the front, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, came under pressure on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, lost the lead to the winner shortly thereafter and gave way. FOREVER ROAD went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and tired. (Rail at 12 Feet)
