SEAL COVE was eased back early then dropped in, settled off the inside, shifted three wide midway through the far turn then four wide late on that bend, rallied inside of TURALLURE in upper stretch, closed determinedly alongside that rival and got up late to narrowly prevail under strong urging. TURALLURE moved in early, was a bit rank while reserved along the rail, dropped to the rear late on the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to make a bid at the sixteenth-pole and just missed in a tough loss. HOOFIT (NZ) raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, waited behind traffic while inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, waited while blocked in upper stretch, found room leaving the furlong marker, rallied along the rail to make a bid at the sixteenth-pole but missed while able to get the show. PARIS VEGAS was rated on the inside, drafted behind the pacesetter on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive, chased into the final furlong, made a bid between horses at the sixteenth-pole but also missed then lost the last spot in the trifecta. MR. COMMONS went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged up while three then four wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, made a bid in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole but was outfinished. VITORIA OLIMPICA (BRZ) broke in at the start, went to the front, set the pace on the inside while into the bit and in hand, was asked at the quarter-pole, led into the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. BIM BAM raced just off the pace while off the inside, shifted three wide midway through the far turn, chased into upper stretch and was out-kicked. BEAU CHOIX raced off the rail on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, went three then four wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and failed to rally. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT was eager while three wide on the first turn, moved up to dispute the pace on the outside, was asked near the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired.
