KITTEN'S DUMPLINGS was sent over to the rail shortly after the start, judiciously took the inside route on the opening bend, was swung outward entering the backstretch, swung out a second time after entering the far turn until three wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled into the lane with a strong five wide run, charged at the front runners, reaching the furlong marker with only a slight deficit to make it, did so, achieving the lead with less than a sixteenth to go, and edged away. WATSDACHANCES (IRE) unhurried for the opening six furlongs, came four wide into the stretch, got straightened away and finished with good energy to procure the place. TAPICAT contently stalked the loose leader from afar, picked up interest and began closing in leaving the half mile pole, was given her cue prior to spinning into the stretch, forged her way to a narrow advantage during the ensuing furling, but with top one closing in fast to her outside, yielded for good a considerable distance beyond the sixteenth pole then got reeled in late for the place. MIDNIGHT WATCH came away in good order, quickly cleared the field and was guided over towards the inside, spurred away from the others, initially pulling a bit on the bit, appeared to hold her biggest advantage as the second fraction was being recorded, had the lead cut into steadily thereafter, got called upon for the stretch, relinquished by the eighth pole, eventually weakening into the final on-the-board position. FAB FLOWERS scraped lightly with the right side of the gate as the field was sent off and running, quickly settled along the rail and saved ground for just over three-quarters, was already under encouragement angling two wide into the stretch, went onward for a couple of jumps before proceeding to be get maneuvered into being the widest of all while racing through the furlong grounds under a steady right handed stick, mustered up a mild kick to outfinish a pair of weak and tired ones. BLOSSOM'S TRAIL tired off a ground-saving journey. MAXIMOVA chased from afar from off the inside, closed the gap, as did all the others upon departing the backstretch, was put three wide at the head of the stretch having already been asked for run, had no offering and gave way.
