WHYWHYWHY was pinched back from between rivals after the start, dropped back early, advanced outside on the turn, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, ran by the leaders in midstretch and drew clear under a drive. WILDCAT HEIR was bumped at the start, was hustled up inside early, rallied three wide nearing the stretch, led between calls in upper stretch and dug in gamely to earn the place award. SPITE THE DEVIL was outrun early, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. POSSE raced close up early, rallied inside entering the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and finished well inside. TITLE CONTENDER was bumped at the start, was outrun early, raced three wide and had no rally. RUN PRODUCTION stumbled at the start, contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. HEAR NO EVIL was hustled along to keep up early and had no response when roused. RAISE AN EMBLEM raced inside and tired. HUSSAR quickly showed in front, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
