Footnotes

HANGINGBYATHREAD outsprinted rivals while angling in on the first turn, set the pace along the inside for six furlongs, shook loose in upper stretch and edged clear under steady pressure. HIGHLY SPOKEN chased the winner in the two path the entire way and held well for the place. ONE GOOD MAN steadied along the inside on the first turn, raced well back in traffic to the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. STATELY PEGASUS saved ground early, raced in traffic while saving ground to the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. GOLD PAGEANTRY was reserved early, raced in traffic between horses for most of the trip and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. KILL DEVIL RUM raced in traffic along the inside for six furlongs and lacked a strong closing response. DANTASTIC steadied while rank in the early stages, moved six wide on the first turn, continued wide while

within striking distance for six furlongs and faded in the stretch. WHEELABOY was never a factor. ELDER SKATESMAN saved ground to no avail. WINAWAY checked along the inside at the half mile pole and failed to menace thereafter. GULCH FEVER faded after going a half. KISS THE DICE steadied repeatedly along the inside in the early stages and was never close thereafter.
