Footnotes

STARJETTA was well placed just off the pace while under a tight hold, waited patiently on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead and proved best under confident hand urging. GRACE AND COURAGE was hard held early, raced three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside while under a hold, gained the lead leaving the far turn, led into the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the place. FRIVOLOUS BUCK steadied while in tight along the hedge on the first turn, was reserved on the inside, moved off the hedge near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. RUMORS OF GLORY dropped to the hedge midway through the first turn, set the pace through sluggish fractions, vied into the final furlong and gave way. CAN SHE DANCE bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved on the inside, steadied off heels near the half-mile pole, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. IN YOUR DREAMS broke awkwardly then was taken in hand, was in a bit tight on the first turn, raced in the back half of the field while under restraint, waited while two to three wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. SOUNDS FAMILIAR raced four then three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, made a mild bid entering the stretch, was forced out then in tight near the furlong marker and came up empty. MAYA CHARLI raced two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. DELIGHTFUL VICKY raced off the hedge on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SWEETHEARTS KISS broke outward and hit the gate then bumped with a rival, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn and dropped out.
