ROGUE'S JEWEL placed to a firm hold soon after the start, patiently tracked the front runner taking the inside route, angled outward under encouragement a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, commenced to rally in earnest once straightened away, collared WHO IS LADY with a sixteenth to go and edged away, driving. WHO IS LADY quickly established control under her own power, tucked along the rail in plenty of time for the run around the bend, cut the pace, facing only mild pressure from the closest pursuer, was asked for a response turning for home. left the eighth pole with a comfortable advantage, got overhauled a sixteenth down the road and had to settle for the place. FREEDOM RINGS reserved along the outside, was placed three wide midway on the far turn, swung into the stretch from the four path and rallied for the show. although never posing a threat to the top twosome at any point during the stretch run. MESA GIRL ducked over to the inside in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, made a rail run that lasted until the furlong marker before flattening out. LADY GRACENOTE three wide around both turns, was asked to pick up the pace from the three-eighths pole, failed to respond. SOUNDS FAMILIAR rated stalking the pacesetter from the outside until the quarter pole, tired. NORTHERN BERKSHIRE underwent a three wide journey and folded.
