Footnotes

BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT chased the pace on the outside, engaged ALAMIST while four then three wide on the turn, was put to the whip nearing the quarter-pole, inched clear approaching the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging. ALARMIST contested the pace on the outside, briefly moved clear near the seven-sixteenths pole, was quickly challenged by BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT on the outside, battled with that rival past the three-sixteenths pole and tired while able to hold the place. ONE WAY TO ROCK was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, chased the pace, jostled with TYCOON CAT outside the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn and weakened while best of the rest. TYCOON CAT raced just off the pace while between rivals, jostled with ONE WAY TO ROCK outside the half-mile pole, dropped back passing that pole, went four wide on the turn and failed to respond. CALGARY ENFORCER contested the pace on the inside, dropped out near the seven-sixteenths pole and faded. SAY LANCELOT bumped the hindquarters of ONE WAY TO ROCK at the start then was in tight and taken up, dropped well off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. SCORPIO DREAMS broke two to three lengths behind the field, raced at the rear, went two to three wide on the turn and was no factor.
