Footnotes

MORNING SHINE made contact with VOLCAT at the start, moved up willingly to contest the pace, continued the battle from the three path on the turn, had CAT GIRL join the fracas from the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, fought her way past the runner up to take charge by midstretch, kicked clear under good handling. SWEET CAT hustled to the front, argued the pace from the two path, was forced to vie between rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to the furlong marker, got shaken off approaching that station, finished willingly for second. VOLCAT was bumped at the start, gave chase while widest on the turn, proved no match for the top twosome. CAT GIRL settled along the inside soon after the start, drew abreast of the front runners with a quick burst of speed, departing the three-eighths pole, vied as the innermost member of a trio until the eighth pole, failed to sustain the bid and backed away. FLY TO THE SKY away well, began to come inward, responding to pressure being applied by the rider on the right shoulder, was yanked hard on the reins and put back on a true course, turned for home in the three path, lugged inward repeatedly during the stretch run. RUN A RISK raced along the outside and was through after completing a half.
