### Footnotes

SPEIGHT OF HAND pressed the pace on the outside, took the lead while three wide on the turn, kicked clear when shaken up in upper stretch, shied from a left-handed whip passing the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip while drawing away near the sixteenth-pole then weaved in and out nearing the wire while much the best. I AIN'T NO SAINT bumped with a rival at the start, moved up to be well placed just off the pace, was asked near the three-eighths pole, chased off the rail through the turn, came three wide into the stretch, battled for the place and narrowly earned that position while no match for the winner. SCORPER came out a bit at the start then was hustled, set the pace under pressure, lost the lead while inside on the turn, was asked to keep up with the winner passing the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with that rival in upper stretch and weakened then just missed the place while able to get the show. BEACON HILL ROAD chased the early pace, dropped back while three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, battled on the outside for the minor awards and just missed those positions. PAISANO CREEK came out and bumped with a rival at the start, moved out at the rear of the field, was ridden along at the back, dropped in to save ground on the turn, came under the whip at the top of the stretch and also just missed the minor awards. DESERT WHEAT was hustled from the start, settled well off the pace while under some urging, raced inside early on the turn, drifted off the rail approaching the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. PRINCE DUBAI leaned in at the start and brushed the gate then bumped with a rival, was pulled off that rival by the rider, moved to the outside and was hustled, chased on the outside, came up empty while four wide on the turn and retreated.
